3. YEAR 3 MOE-OUTWARD BOUND SINGAPORE CHALLENGE (MOC) PROGRAMME/ NLS OBS PARALLEL PROGRAMME

The MOE Outward Bound Singapore (OBS) Challenge (MOC) programme is a 5-day course that Year 3 students attend from 21 July 2025 to 25 July 2025. Students stay at the OBS campsite where they take part in challenging outdoor activities like sea expeditions, kayaking, rock climbing and high elements courses. The programme helps build confidence, resilience and leadership skills while students learn to work together and push beyond their comfort zones through outdoor adventures. For Year 3 students who are not able to attend the MOC, they will attend a parallel programme organised by our school's Sports and Wellness Department.

4. NRIC REGISTRATION (FOR STUDENTS BORN IN 2010)

The Identity Card (IC) is a compulsory document that Singapore citizens and permanent residents must register when they reach the age of 15 (before their 16th birthday). All students **born in 2010** will be eligible to register. ICA works closely with MOE to bring the convenience of the NRIC registration exercise to MOE schools' students. ICA will conduct a biometrics enrolment for your child in NorthLight School on **Tuesday, 15 July 2025**.

To ensure that your child's/ward's biometrics are enrolled smoothly, Parents/ Guardians **MUST pre-register** their child/ward online using the QR code below or using the following link: <https://www.ica.gov.sg/documents/ic/registration> by **Thursday, 10 July 2025**.



You will be required to:

- Verify your child's/ward's particulars. If you wish to add Chinese/Jawi/Tamil characters, please include them during the online submission under the 'Ethnic Name' field. If you do not include them in your application, ICA will not be able to amend your application thereafter.
- Upload your child's/ward's photograph and supporting documents (where applicable).
- Make online payment (go.gov.sg/icreg) for your child's/ward's NRIC prior to the school exercise (\$10 for Singapore Citizens/ \$50 for Permanent Residents). ICA will not process your child's/ward's application if payment is not made.

5. MEET-THE-PARENTS SESSION (YEAR 1 TO YEAR 4 STUDENTS)

The Meet-the-Parents (MTP) Session will be held on **Friday, 11 July 2025**. During this important session, teachers will share updates about your child's/ward's learning experiences and progress. This platform allows for meaningful dialogue between parents/guardians and teachers, enabling discussions about your child's/ward's specific needs and areas for development. We value this opportunity to strengthen our partnership in supporting your child's/ward's educational journey.


7. SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY
